TASTING NOTES

Colour	Dark red.
Nose / Bouquet	Floral, youthful nose, shows some liquorice and mulberry.
Taste / Palate	Fermentation in a combination of new and two-year-old American oak, has left a legacy of smoky toastiness, a trace of vanillan and soft tannins. Intense blackberry and plum on the palate, with dark chocolate and bitter coffee which, in balance with the soft tannins, results in a wine of supple consistency, solid structure, and an agreeable level of complexity. Not released until 2006, this wine won Silver at the Decanter World Wine Awards in 2006 and Bronze at the London International Wine Challenge in 2005.
Food Pairing	Enjoy with full, rich dishes such as rare roast beef, venison and roast duck. This wine also suits pairing with Jarlsberg, Swiss and Edam cheeses.
